Councillor activities and updates for February 2024.

- Attended the Regular Meeting of Council on February 7th.
- Attended the Municipal Development Plan Committee meeting on February 7th.
 - Discussion of what we would like to see addressed in the MDP and what the process entails. Some frustration over the survey expressed. Consensus that we should review the MDP from 2012 to facilitate a more focussed discussion.
- Attended Emerging Trends in Municipal Law seminar in Calgary on February 8th.
 - Several presentations on emergent municipal law matters with bear pit question period at the end. Interesting presentation on tax incentives.
 - Councillor Nelson travelled with me and won a door prize at the end.
- Attended Champion Recreation meeting in the Champion Community Hall on February 22nd.
