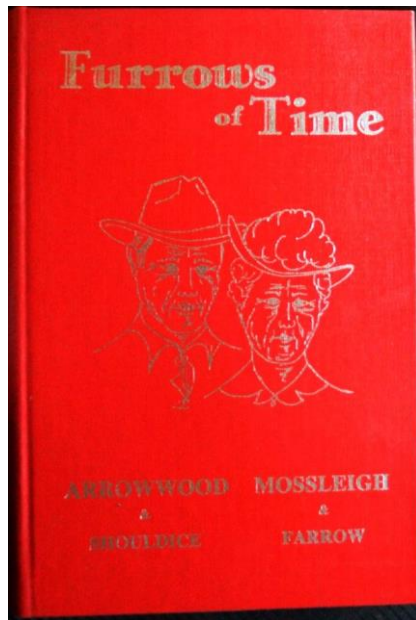

# Projected Expenses – Publication





This quote is only an estimate for the figures we came up with (most of which are totally a guesstimate) as it is based on the following:

- Number of books ordered (we suggested 750)

- Number of pages in the book (we guessed at 650)

- Number of pictures in the book (we guessed about 1400)

- Color or black & white (we chose black & white – colored would add another \$25.73 per book)

- Size of the book (8 ½ x 11)

- Hard Cover

- Picture on inside of both covers and adjoining page

- Type of paper (57 lb Rolland Enviro Opaque Offset White – we didn't choose, may be standard?)

- Cover Design (using standard magnesium foil stamp die on cover and spine in one color - copper or brass die would be charged extra)

None of this will be finalized until we start putting the book together.

750 books @ \$61.75 - \$46,252.60      500 books would cost \$78.33 per book

We have collected a \$30 deposit on books pre-ordered (365 so far) and are hoping to keep the final cost of the book at a reasonable price. Grant money will help us to achieve this.

Payment for the book is 1/3 of estimate down payment, 1/3 when book goes into production and 1/3 after we receive the book (not sure what the time frame is there).
